of the offense charged in **Count Four**, conspiracy to commit offenses against the United States.

Guilty
(Guilty/Not Guilty)

of the offense charged in **Count Five**, obstruction of justice by attempted witness tampering of Witness 1.

Guilty
(Guilty/Not Guilty)

of the offense charged in **Count Six**, obstruction of justice by attempted witness tampering of Witness 2.

Guilty
(Guilty/Not Guilty)

of the offense charged in **Count Seven**, conspiracy to attempt to obstruct justice.
