INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about August 31, 2020, in the District of Wyoming, the Defendant, **VICTORIA MADIGAN**, in a matter within the jurisdiction of the executive branch of the Government of the United States, that is, an application for housing assistance submitted to the Cheyenne Housing Authority, which administered the Housing Choice Voucher program on behalf of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, did willfully and knowingly make materially false, fictitious, and fraudulent statements and representations by falsely certifying she had no assets or income besides unemployment benefits that ended in July 2020, when in truth and fact, as the Defendant then and there knew, she and her household had income and support from working for and carrying on business for The Enchanted Bean.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1001(a)(2).
