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FINAL ORDER OF FORFEITURE

The government moved for a final order of forfeiture of the following property:

- a. credit card blanks; and
- b. a black computer tower.

ECF No. 125. The United States is entitled to possession of this property pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 981(a)(1)(C), 982(a)(1), and 982(a)(2) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).

A preliminary order of forfeiture entered earlier. ECF No. 89. Pursuant to Rule G(4)(a)(iv)(C) of the Supplemental Rules for Certain Admiralty or Maritime Claims and Asset Forfeiture Actions, notice of the forfeiture action was published on an official internet government forfeiture site for at least 30 consecutive days. ECF No. 123. No person or entity has filed a claim setting forth their interest in the property.

It is now ordered that the property is condemned and forfeited to the United States.
