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**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

1. On or about August 4, 2020, in the State and Eastern District of Wisconsin,

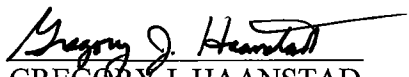
**ROBERT J. SOLBERG**

knowingly and willfully made materially false statements and representations within the jurisdiction of the executive branch of the United States government.

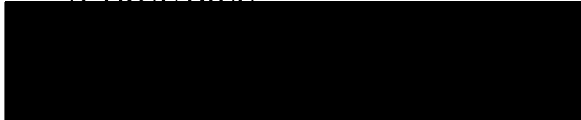
2. Namely, he falsely and fraudulently declared on a United States Small Business Administration application that he was not then subject to a felony indictment and had not pleaded guilty to any felony, when he knew, in fact, he was subject to an indictment, and had pleaded guilty to a felony on February 7, 2020, in case 19-CR-214 then pending in the Eastern District of Wisconsin.

3. The defendant was on release pursuant to an order dated December 2, 2019, from the United States District Court in the Eastern District of Wisconsin, which order notified said defendant of the potential effect of committing an offense while on pretrial release.

All violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1001(a)(2) and 3147.
