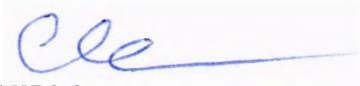

1343 - Wire Fraud (Felony)

The United States Attorney charges:

On May 14, 2020, within the Southern District of California, and elsewhere, defendant THOMAS ZOLEZZI, having knowingly devised a material scheme and artifice to defraud and to obtain money and property by means of materially false and fraudulent pretenses, representations, and promises, knowingly transmitted and caused to be transmitted by means of a wire communication in interstate commerce certain writings, signs, signals, and sounds, that is, an application for a Payroll Protection Program Loan in the amount of \$11,354 from inside of California to outside of California, to pay for his personal expenses instead of paying the salary of his employees. All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1343.
