**JUDGMENT AND COMMITMENT ORDER
ON REVOCATION OF PROBATION
(For Offenses Committed On or After November 1, 1987)**

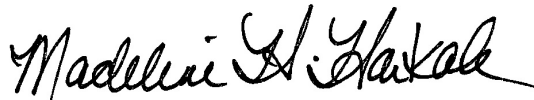
The defendant, JOHN DAVID SCOGGINS, was represented by Jerry S. Barclay.

On May 1, 2024, the Court sentenced Mr. Scoggins to probation for a period of 60 months, (Doc. 44). Mr. Scoggins has violated the terms of probation. Therefore, the Court REVOKES Mr. Scoggins's probation.

As pronounced on August 22, 2024, Mr. Scoggins is committed to the custody of United States Bureau of Prisons for a term of **TIME SERVED** as of the date a bed becomes available at an inpatient facility approved by Mr. Scoggins's supervising officer. The Court imposes 36 months of supervised release subject to all special conditions in the original judgment.

The defendant is remanded to the custody of United States Marshal
