**JUDGMENT AND COMMITMENT ORDER
ON REVOCATION OF SUPERVISED RELEASE
(For Offenses Committed On or After November 1, 1987)**

The defendant, JOHN DAVID SCOGGINS, was represented by Jerry S. Barclay.

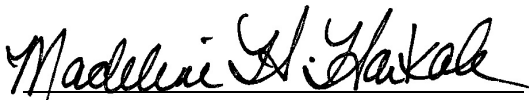
Mr. Scoggins was sentenced on April 30, 2024 and was placed on probation for a period of 60 months. Mr. Scoggins had a revocation hearing on June 7, 2024, and a special condition was added to his Probation. Mr. Scoggins's probation was revoked on August 22, 2024, and he was sentenced to time served and transferred to an in-patient program. On March 7, 2025, his probation was revoked again, and he was sentenced to time served and a supervised release term of 36 months.

Mr. Scoggins has violated the terms and conditions of his supervised release. The Court revokes his supervised release. As pronounced on July 31, 2025, Mr. Scoggins is committed to the custody of the United States Bureau of Prisons to be imprisoned for a term of three (3) months, with credit for time served in custody on the current warrant, and 24 months of supervised release to follow. The Court adds the following special condition:

1) The defendant shall remain in custody after completion of the custodial sentence until a bed space at an in-patient treatment facility is secured. A separate Order for Release will be issued upon securing a bed space that is mutually approved by the U.S. Probation Office and the attorney of record. Upon release, the defendant is to report directly to the in-patient treatment facility. Transportation must be approved in advance by the U.S. Probation Office. The defendant must attend and complete all phases of treatment recommended by the treatment provider. All passes must be approved by the U.S. Probation Office.

The defendant is remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal.
