ORDER

This matter having come before the Court upon the emergent application of Defendant Adrienne T. Ponzo, through counsel, Troy A. Archie, Esq., seeking an Order extending Defendant's voluntary self-surrender date or, in the alternative, recommending designation to a Bureau of Prisons Federal Medical Center or other medically appropriate facility; and the Court having reviewed Defendant's Motion, supporting Certification, Memorandum of Law, updated medical records, physician opinions, and all papers submitted in support thereof; and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2026,

ORDERED that Defendant Adrienne T. Ponzo's Motion is GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendant's voluntary self-surrender date is hereby extended until August 21, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., at which time Defendant shall voluntarily surrender to the Bureau of Prisons facility designated by the Bureau of Prisons; and it is further

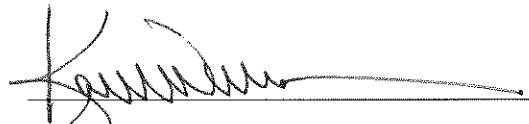
ORDERED that Defendant shall remain subject to all previously imposed conditions of release pending her voluntary surrender; and it is further

ORDERED that the Court respectfully recommends that the Bureau of Prisons designate Defendant to a Federal Medical Center or other medically appropriate Bureau of Prisons facility capable of providing specialized treatment for Defendant's documented severe respiratory disease, chronic spinal condition, and ongoing medical needs; and it is further

ORDERED that the Court further recommends that, to the extent practicable and consistent with Bureau of Prisons policies, Defendant be designated to the medically appropriate Bureau of Prisons institution nearest her residence in the State of Delaware or the surrounding region so as to facilitate family visitation and support, particularly in light of the significant medical limitations presently affecting Defendant's spouse and the family's ongoing caregiving responsibilities for their handicapped children; and it is further

ORDERED that except as expressly modified herein, all previously imposed conditions of release shall remain in full force and effect.
