SECOND PRELIMINARY
ORDER OF FORFEITURE

AHMED SHARIF OMAR-HASHIM, also
known as "Salah Donyale,"

Defendant.

Based on the United States' Second Motion for a Preliminary Order of Forfeiture; on the Indictment; on the Plea Agreement entered into between the United States and Defendant Ahmed Sharif Omar-Hashim; and on the Court having found that certain property is subject to forfeiture pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 981(a)(1)(c) in connection with 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), and Rule 32.2(b)(2)(C) and (e), the United States has established the requisite nexus between such property and the offense to which the Defendant pled guilty, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The United States' Second Motion for a Preliminary Order of Forfeiture (ECF No. 868) is GRANTED;
2. The following property is forfeited to the United States pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 981(a)(1)(c) in conjunction with 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c):

- a. The real property located at 2722 and 2742 Park Avenue South, Minneapolis, Minnesota (“the Property”);
3. The Attorney General or his authorized designee may seize and maintain custody and control of the Property pending the entry of a Final Order of Forfeiture;
4. Defendant shall receive credit against the money judgment forfeiture for the net forfeited value of each asset that is forfeited from him in connection with this case, including his twenty percent interest in the Property;
5. The United States shall, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(n)(1), as incorporated by 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), publish and give notice of this Order and its intent to dispose of the Property in such manner as the Attorney General may direct;
6. Following the Court’s disposition of all petitions filed pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(n)(2) or, if no petitions are filed, following the expiration of the time period specified within which to file such petitions, the United States shall have clear title to the Property and may warrant good title to any subsequent purchaser or transferee; and

7. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce this Order, and to amend it as necessary pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 32.2(e).
