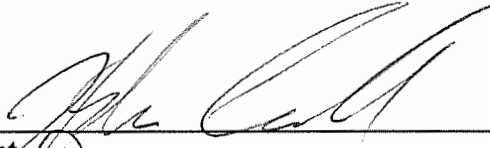

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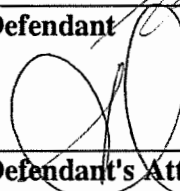
CONSENT TO HAVE A PLEA TAKEN

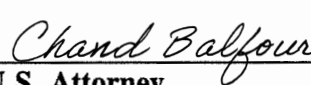
After having discussed this matter fully with my counsel, I hereby consent to enter my plea before a Magistrate Judge.
